The purpose of this meeting was to inform the community about the City's municipal separate storm sewer system and combined sewer overflow control program providing information on the City's storm sewer system functions and how combined sewer overflows are managed. The meeting also served as the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Program annual update.

The meeting began with an overview of the City's stormwater and combined sewer systems. Information was presented on Peoria's separate storm sewer system including the stormwater management program. Information was also presented on the City's combined sewer system including a short video describing how combined sewers work, Consent Decree requirements and timeline, CSO and green infrastructure (GI) definitions, CSO control program overview and use of GI, and description of recently completed and designed projects. Attendees were informed of storm sewer system Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination (IDDE). An overview of the City's CSO Program website was provided.
